#### Project Pipeline Released at DC Builds!

Last Friday, Mayor Bowser and OP3 hosted *DC Builds!*, a half-day forum that brought together hundreds of public officials, potential partners, policy experts, and residents to discuss the state of the District's infrastructure. #### Window to Submit Unsolicited Proposals Announced

Beginning November 28, 2016 and eating on January 26, 2017, OP3 will be open to accept unsolicited proposals to spur innovative solutions to the District's infrastructure needs. Detailed requirements for these proposals are included in the Public-Private Partnerships Act of 2014 as well as <u>OP3's rules and guidelines</u>.
