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Request for Alternative Proposals – Qualifications for Daly Building

Yesterday, the Office of Public-Private Partnerships (OP3), in coordination with the Department of General Services (DGS) and Metropolitan Police Department (MPD), released the Request for Alternative Proposals - Qualifications (RFAP-Q) for the rehabilitation of the Henry J. Daly Building, which currently serves as headquarters for the Metropolitan Police Department (MPD). As described in the procurement document ([link here](#)), interested bidders will have until June 11, 2018 to submit their statement of qualifications. OP3 will then work with a review panel to select the most qualified teams to submit a full proposal for the renovation on the Daly Building. In anticipation of the release of a draft Request for Proposals, the District is holding a series of public hearings to solicit feedback on the streetlight modernization project. The hearings will be held in town hall style format, with a public presentation from government representatives followed by 3 minutes of speaking time for each individual who registers.
